This sentence is a **command**. It is used to give an instruction. Commands are usually very short and include a bossy verb (a verb that tells someone what to do). They end with a full stop.

What is your favourite colour?
This sentence is a **question**. It is used to ask something. Questions usually end with a question mark.

I can't believe we won!
This sentence is an **exclamation**. It is used to show a strong feeling like surprise or anger. Exclamations can also be a statement or command, but they end with an exclamation mark.

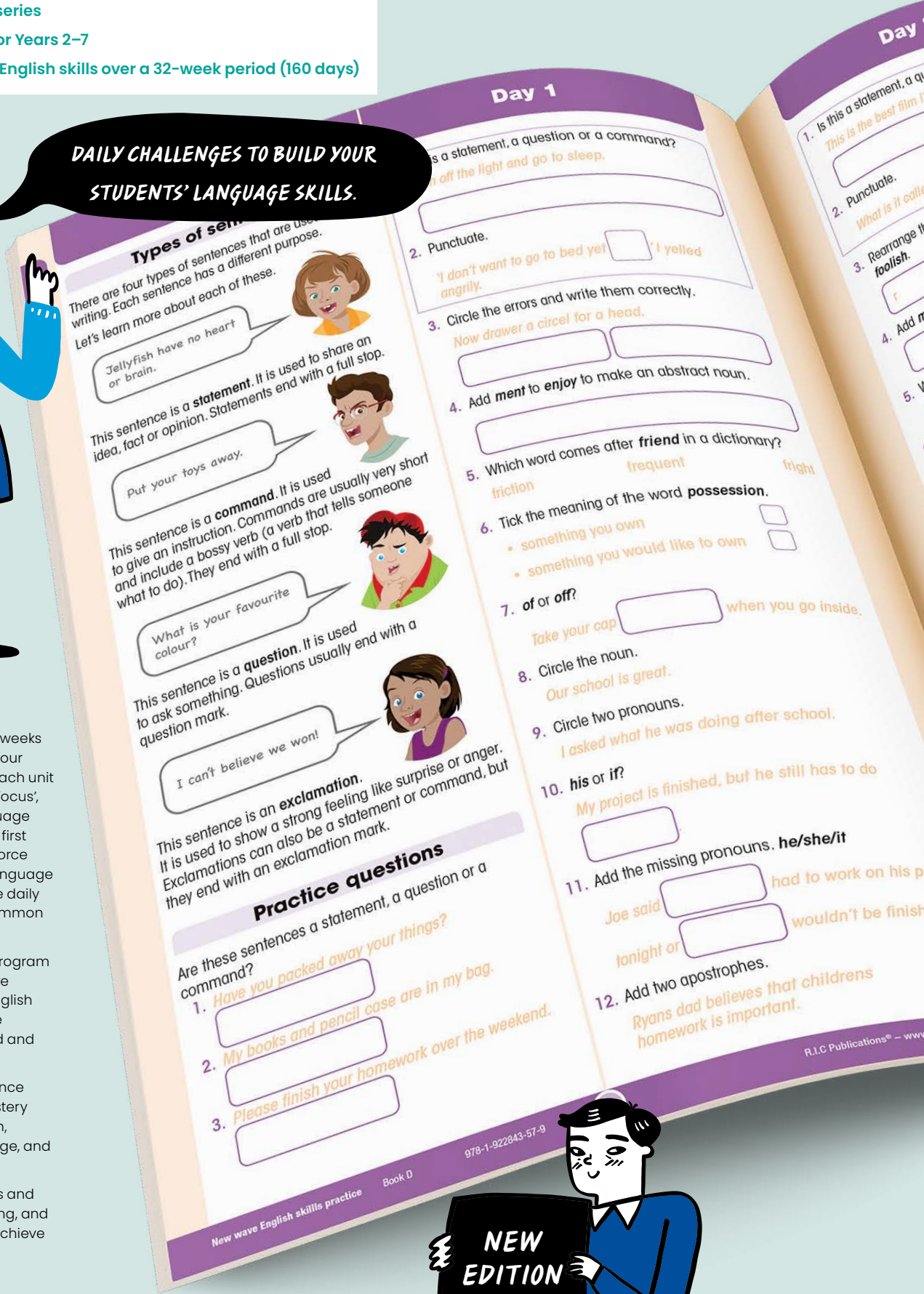
