Choose one of the easy recipes below to make for Christmas.


Santa's cheese ball snack

Ingredients

- 250 g package cream cheese
- 250 g jar of cheese spread
- 125 g grated cheddar cheese
- 1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
- crushed walnuts
- crackers or vegie sticks to serve

Instructions


1. Mix all ingredients except walnuts and form into a ball.
2. Roll in crushed walnuts.
3. Serve with crackers or vegie sticks.



Ice-cream Christmas trees

Ingredients

- cone-shaped party hats lined with wax paper
- softened ice-cream
- spoon or scoop
- sugar dyed green/green sprinkles
- red and green M&M[®]s
- soft, yellow lolly flattened with rolling pin and cut into star shape



Instructions

1. Scoop ice-cream into hats.
2. Set in freezer.
3. Carefully remove ice-cream from hats.
4. Decorate ice-cream with sugar or sprinkles, M&M[®]s and 'star'.


Reindeer antlers

Ingredients

- 1 packet dark chocolate chips
- 85 g thin sweet pretzel sticks
- baking paper on biscuit tray
- red and green M&M[®]s

Instructions

1. Melt chocolate.
2. Remove bowl from heat.
3. Dip pretzels in chocolate.
4. Place onto biscuit tray.
5. Use fingers to form antlers.
6. Before antlers set, press a red M&M[®] gently into centre for nose and red and green ones along antlers to decorate.





